

Wichita Eisenhower National Airport (ICT) is a small hub air carrier and general aviation complex, providing accommodations for all aircraft, as well as the latest innovations in passenger convenience, safety and efficiency. As Kansas’ largest airport, ICT draws passengers from the Wichita metro area, two-thirds of Kansas, and Northern Oklahoma.

Wichita Dwight D. Eisenhower National Airport is conveniently located 5.2 miles southwest of Wichita’s central business district. It is bordered by U.S. Highway 54/500, Highway K-42, and has easy access to I- 235. A total of 507 acres are available for development.

## Wichita Eisenhower National Airport (ICT) Advantages



The Wichita Airport Authority leases land and improvements on a long-term basis to tenants who receive these potential benefits from the Authority’s tax-exempt status, including the following:

1. No general property taxes payable on the land owned by the Authority
2. No general property taxes payable on improvements owned by the Authority
3. Improvements can be financed with municipal bonds at tax-exempt rates of interest
4. Sales tax exemption for development on airport property.

Colonel James Jabara Airport is a general aviation reliever for the Wichita metro area, with an average of 104 aircraft operations per day. Located at 3512 N Webb Rd, the airport is conveniently located in the developing business district of Northeast Wichita, and has easy access to Highway K-254 and Highway K-96.

Colonel James Jabara Airport is home to the National Center for Aviation Training and Wichita Area Technical College. The NCAT also incorporates new facilities for Wichita State University’s National Institute for Aviation Research.
