The Wichita Airport Authority leases land and improvements on a long-term basis to tenants who receive potential benefits from the Authority's tax-exempt status.



- No general property taxes payable on the land and improvements owned by the Authority
- Improvements can be financed with municipal bonds at tax-exempt rates of interest
- Sales tax exemption for development on airport property using Airport Special Facility Revenue Bonds

Colonel James Jabara Airport is a general aviation reliever for the Wichita Metro area, with an average of 110 aircraft operations per day. The airport is conveniently located in the developing business district of Northeast Wichita and has easy access to Highway K-254 and Highway K-96.

Colonel James Jabara Airport is home to WSU Tech for aviation training. WSU Tech also incorporates new facilities for Wichita State University's National Institute for Aviation Research.
