



MEETING MINUTES

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Darge took roll call. Chair Frazer called the meeting to order. A quorum was established.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve the previous meeting's minutes was made by Greene and seconded by Bonnell. Motion passed unanimously.

Romo discussed recent development activity at Jabara Airport, highlighting the significant construction now underway.

Hinkel reported on:

- WSU Tech groundbreaking will be held August 22.
- Master Plan meeting which is open to the public will be held on 8/5/25 from 4:30 – 5:30.

Romo referenced an article in the Wichita Business Journal regarding potential non-aeronautical development on the northeast corner of 45th Street and Webb Rd. Three possible tracts are currently under environmental review for future development.

Romo noted ongoing staffing and succession planning efforts, including the posting of Wise's and Oswald's positions.
